## John Paul Sulek

John Paul Sulek, also known as Johnny Kwaitkowski, of Detroit died on Friday, July 22 of a heart attack. Sulek was 54.

Sulek was born near Lancaster, Pennsylvania on June 28, 1940 and grew up in that area. He moved to Detroit to study at Wayne State University. At the time of his death Sulek was working on a Master's degree in Art and Film History at Wayne.

Sulek worked for twenty-five years at the Hotel St. Regis in Detroit as a desk clerk. He also was a member of Studs 30 and had served as President of the club. He loved the arts, films, traveling, and attending plays at the Fisher Theatre.

Survivors include his special friend Bill, a brother, one sister, an uncle, the brothers of Studs 30 and Wolf Pack and many friends.

Funeral services were held at the Howe-Peterson Funeral Home in Dearborn on Wednesday, July 27 and burial was at St. Hedwig Cemetery in Dearborn Heights. A Memorial Service in celebration of the life of John Paul Sulek will be held later this fall.
