Ben C. Lowery, 34, of 403 Riley St. died at 3:04 a.m. on Monday, May 18, 1987 in the University of Michigan Hospital, Ann Arbor, following a long illness. He had been hospitalized for five weeks.

Services were held at 2 p.m. on Thursday, May 21st in the Buhl-Cover Funeral Home with the Rev. John Jackson of Calvary Baptist Church officiating. Burial was in Maple Grove Cemetery.

Born August 25, 1952, in Ann Arbor, he was the son of Robert E. and Arnita M. (Cole) Lowery.
