Brian Scholz, 30, of Warren, Michigan died Sunday afternoon Oct. 13, at his home, apparently by his own hand.†

Brian was a popular and well-known figure in the Detroit gay community, having lived and worked in the Ferndale, Royal Oak and greater Detroit area. His work over the years included stints as a bakery chef, cook, caterer, waiter, dancer, and valet at locations such as Malebox, Pronto, Club Inuendo, and the Edge, as well as Cobalt, Karma, and Toast in Ferndale.

Brian donated much time and effort to gay community organizations and causes, working with MAPP, WAGS, Pride festivals, Pet Walks, and marches, and AIDS walks. He attended the boat cruises, the picnics, the bar guild follies, the hay rides, and most recently collected pledges and walked in Royal Oak's Steppin' Out AIDS Walk.

Brian turned 30 this past August, and recently rented a home in Warren. Details on funeral arrangements were not available at press time. Brian was bright, handsome, and charming, and his sparkling eyes and wide smile will be missed by his many friends.
