1961 — 1989

Age 28, died November 3, 1989 at University Hospital, Ann Arbor, after a two-year battle with AIDS. He was born June 20, 1961 in Ann Arbor, a son of Richard Emmit and Louise (Forte) Turner. He was a life-long resident of Ann Arbor and was former owner of Parkway Printing Co.
